Resolutions from Standing Committees



Only policy resolutions are brought forward from Standing Committees to the Annual General Meeting; administrative or operational resolutions are not.

All forwarded resolutions have been reviewed, accepted and, in some cases, amended by Presidents' Council.

EDUCATION POLICY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution I

That Presidents' Council look into the private society under the BC Prior Learning Assessment Network (PLAN) with regards to the provision of prior learning assessment and our institutions because it appears that money and work is being taken from our members.

Committee Resolution 2

That FPSE host/cohost a forum on learning environments and supportive signature pedagogies.

HUMAN RIGHTS & INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 3

That FPSE demand all Canadian troops be withdrawn from Afghanistan no later than December 2011, as decided by resolution of the House of Commons.

Committee Resolution 4

That FPSE recommend that each Local ensure that all cameras on campus, and all those proposed, are FIPPA Section 26 compliant and operate within Office of the Information and Privacy Commissioner's guidelines.

NON-REGULAR FACULTY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 5

That FPSE budget \$10,000 to resource initiatives to support the strategic campaign to advance equity for non-regular faculty objectives of FPSE and member locals related to non-regular faculty.

PENSION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 6

That FPSE Presidents' Council implement Item #2 of Motion #40 from the 2009 AGM:

BE IT RESOLVED THAT "the [FPSE] Executive will investigate the possibility for an independent, professionally developed survey of active and retired members on pension-related issues so that any "Partners' Table" will have the best possible reading of the opinions of our active members and retirees, and the proposal for such a survey will be made for Presidents' Council approval."

Committee Resolution 7

That Presidents' Council direct the development of a comprehensive education program for the membership and the general public, about the facts on public sector Pension Plans.

Committee Resolution 8

That Dominique Roelants be re-appointed as a College Pension Plan Trustee for an additional term beginning in 2012.

PROFESSIONAL & SCHOLARLY DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 9

That non-regulars have access to professional and scholarly development funds on a pro-rated basis across all institutions, and that this should be a bargaining priority.

Committee Resolution 10

That all faculty receive professional and scholarly development funds system-wide.

WORKPLACE HEALTH, SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution II

That FPSE endorse June 1st as Injured Workers' Day and recommend that its locals do the same.

Committee Resolution 12

That FPSE write to the Premier encouraging the designation of June 1st as Injured Workers' Day.

Committee Resolution 13

That FPSE use "Workers' Compensation Board" or "WCB" in its internal and external communication, as opposed to "Work Safe BC", and that it urge its locals to do the same.

Committee Resolution 14

That FPSE develop workshops to educate members regarding their rights and responsibilities related to the risk of potential violence associated with students.

Committee Resolution 15

That FPSE offer workshops to assist locals in dealing with workplace stress.

Committee Resolution 16

That FPSE ask the BC Federation of Labour to develop a campaign to make Occupational Health and Safety a higher profile issue in the next provincial election.

Committee Resolution 17

That FPSE ask the BC Federation of Labour to develop an educational awareness program regarding the health hazards associated with CFLs (compact fluorescent light bulbs) and also that the BC Federation of Labour advocate for the reinstatement of safe alternatives to CFLs.
