Resolutions from Standing Committees

Only policy resolutions are brought forward from Standing Committees to the Annual General Meeting; administrative or operational resolutions are not.

All forwarded resolutions have been reviewed, accepted and, in some cases, amended by Presidents' Council.

EDUCATION POLICY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution I

That FPSE work with and contribute to the BC Federation of Labour's Young Workers' Program to provide curriculum and resources on the benefits of unionization.

Committee Resolution 2

That FPSE work with the Canadian Federation of Students to develop curriculum and resources on workplace rights and the benefits of unionization.

Committee Resolutions 3

That FPSE expand its Labour Relations and Public Policy Advocacy Certificate Program to include new programs that provide faculty members with information on the role, importance and benefits of unions in their workplace.

Committee Resolutions 4

That FPSE support a policy development process, led by the Education Policy Committee, on learning environments. This process will include the gathering of local input through a workshop in the Fall of 2010 and summarizing that input in a position paper for Presidents' Council.

HUMAN RIGHTS & INTERNATIONAL SOLIDARITY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 5

That the International Solidarity Fund be increased to \$30,000 from the current \$15,000.

NON-REGULAR FACULTY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 6

To recommend that FPSE add the following policy to the *Policy and Procedures Manual*:

3.5.3.7: FPSE endorses the CAUT Pro Rata model and encourages all locals to adopt the model in their Collective Agreements.

Committee Resolution 7

That FPSE develop a strategic campaign to advance equity for non-regular faculty and that the campaign be directed towards institutions, government, students and the public. The purpose of the campaign shall be to build support for the long term bargaining objectives of FPSE and member locals related to nonregular faculty.

PENSION ADVISORY COMMITTEE

Committee Resolutions 8

That Weldon Cowan be re-appointed as a FPSE College Pension Plan Trustee.

Committee Resolution 9

That John Wilson be appointed to the Trustee position due to become vacant in the summer of 2011.

WORKPLACE HEALTH, SAFETY & ENVIRONMENT COMMITTEE

Committee Resolution 10

That FPSE work with the BC Federation of Labour for the reinstatement of loss of earnings pensions.

Committee Resolution II

That FPSE work with the BC Federation of Labour to help them undertake a campaign that cancer prevention is a public health issue, with particular emphasis on environment and occupational factors.

Committee Resolution 12

That FPSE work with the BC Federation of Labour to create a network of progressive health and safety researchers with the necessary academic credentials and experience to draft and engage in research funding that is available from WorkSafe BC.
