Page 104 | \$100,000 | 16 North Island College Faculty Association

Preamble We have reached a milestone year in our federation's history and because it is important to showcase our solidarity, struggles, campaigns, and achievements,

[141] Access up to \$100,000 from the contingency fund to provide financial resources to create the FPSE history project that celebrates 50 years of being a federation.

[138] That FPSE fund DRISC such that the committee may hold 5 meetings for 2019/2020.

Preamble Because we want to encourage greater participation of women in union and academic roles, and women must feel confident to run for positions of leadership within their unions, workplaces and communities; and because SIUW provides invaluable leadership and union training for women and helps to establish life long connections between union sisters; and because the number of women that apply for participation in SIUW outnumber the available positions each year; and because there is a discount for multiple registrations; and because the 2019 event is in Vancouver;

[095] SWC recommends that FPSE increase the number of participants it sends to SIUW to 12.

Preamble Whereas a federation of progressive educators ought to respect and be motivated by the evidence-based conclusions drawn by the IPCC (Intergovernmental Panel on Climate Change), who have called for a global, urgent, and proportionate response to the existential threat to our species presented by catastrophic, anthropogenic, climate breakdown;

Whereas the labour movement, our federation, and our locals have not yet fundamentally changed our way of doing the business of union work so as to drastically reduce our individual and collective implicatedness in climate breakdown, but because we must, and right away;

[202] That FPSE will allocate up to \$50,000 to form an emergency standing committee for 2019-2020 whose primary goal will be to help our federation and our locals make more positive contributions to addressing the climate catastrophe by serving an advisory role on, and providing recommendations regarding, all issues related to climate and our work's impact on it; that the committee will formally replicate the structure, rules, and level of resourcing of our existing standing committees, and that they receive direction from, and be subordinate to, Presidents' Council.

Preamble Because the promotion of FPSE's *Whose Land is it Anyway? A Manual for Decolonization*, as approved in Resolution 146 at the 2018 FPSE AGM, is not complete, including translation into French and the production of an audiobook,

[197] The Federation will (1) work with an indigenous rights support group from France, which has developed a French translation of the book, to promote and distribute it; and (2) work with members of Emily Carr University of Art + Design Faculty Association (Local 22) and Indigenous radio station Nuxalk (91.1 FM Bella Coola), both of whom have indicated readiness to support production of the audiobook, significantly reducing costs; and (3) allocate \$15,000 in the 2019-2020 fiscal year to support the promotion and distribution of the book's French translation; the production of an audio-book version of the book; printing of additional copies for distribution to FPSE member locals.
